Container Inspection





- Front Wall
 - Left Side
- Right Side
 - Floor
- Ceiling/Roof
- Inside / Outside Doors
 - Interior Dimensions
 - Locking Mechanisms
- Outside/Undercarriage



- Front wall/Left/Right/Floor/Ceiling
 - o Holes/openings
 - Large areas of repairs
 - **▼** These areas may appear to be recently painted.
 - o False walls
 - **▼** These may be more easily detectable through dimensional measurement.
- Inside/Outside doors
 - o Holes/openings
 - Repaired holes directly behind locking mechanism
 - Door hinges operating properly



- Interior dimensions(L x W x H in cm)
 - o 20' container
 - × 589 x 235 x 239
 - o 40' container
 - × 1202 x 235 x 239
 - o 40' HC container
 - × 1202 x 235 x 269
 - o 45' container
 - × 1357 x 235 x 269

Measurements may vary by up to 5cm depending on manufacturer.

Measurements are to be verified with a length of rope cut to length and used to measure the inside of the container.



- Outside / undercarriage
 - o Holes/openings
 - Large areas of repairs
 - **▼** These areas may look recently painted.
 - o Inspect undercarriage for recent repairs or foreign objects.

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- o All containers must be inspected prior to loading.
- All containers must be swept clean of all debris.
 - × Including but not limited too: leaves, seeds, insects, insect eggs.
- C-TPAT "Supplier Questionnaire" must be completed and submitted with the shipping documents for Camuto/VCS Shipments.



- Locking Mechanism
 - Rivets should all be the same.
 - Should not be bolts





- Seal Affixing Process:
 - Only designated, authorized employees must distribute and affix container seals for integrity purposes.
 - The fewer people who have access to seal(s), the better!
 - O Unauthorized employees must never handle container seals!





• Seal Affixing Process:

- Factory shipments that can be sealed with a high security seal that meets or exceeds the most current International Standardization Organization (ISO) 17712 standard for high security seals.
- Seals should be affixed to the right door of the container/ trailer on the hasp that has the welded rivet. This practice will raise the level of security for the shipment.
- After the seal is affixed to the container, an authorized employee should make sure that the seal is secure.





- Seal Affixing Process:
 - Seals should be affixed to the right door on the hasp that has the welded rivet.





• DESTINATION INSPECTION CRITERIA



- Guard Shack inspects container:
 - Front Wall
 - Left Side
 - Right Side
 - Outside Doors
 - Locking Mechanisms
 - o Seal
 - × Tires
 - × Lights
 - Chassis / Undercarriage for tampering

Findings are indicated on the "NJDC Container Inspection Sheet " that is then maintained in the import shipment file for all arriving containers.



- Front wall/Left/Right
 - Holes/openings
 - Large areas of repairs
 - **▼** These areas may appear to be recently painted.
- Outside doors
 - Holes/openings
 - Repaired holes directly behind locking mechanism.
 - Door hinges operating properly



- Locking Mechanism
 - o Rivets should all be the same.
 - Should not be bolts






- Seal Affixing Process:
 - o Only designated, authorized employees verify the seal integrity
 - ➤ View the seal and container locking mechanism.
 - ➤ Tug on the seal to make sure it is affixed properly.
 - × Twist and turn the seal to make sure it does not come off.
 - ➤ Be informed that threaded seals can be unscrewed to gain access.





- Seal Affixing Process:
 - Seals should be affixed to the right door of the container/ trailer on the hasp that has the welded rivet. This practice will raise the level of security for the shipment.





- Seal Affixing Process:
 - Seals should be affixed to the right door on the hasp that has the welded rivet





- Seal Discrepancies are immediately advised to the import department for resolution and prior to the container being permitted into the yard.
 - o If it is after hours follow the:
 - "Off Hours Container Receipt Process"
